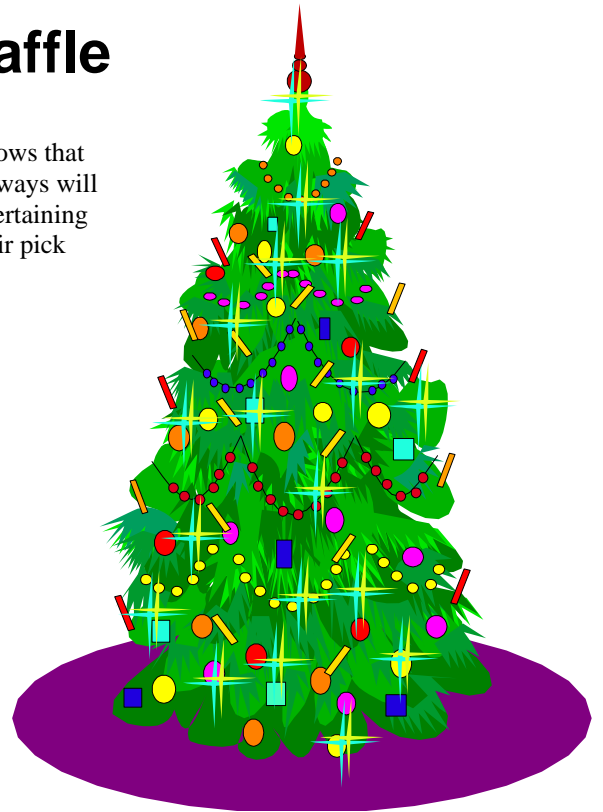
December Presentation and Raffle
